Not only were there children's dancing groups performing in Polish national dress and singing, but a newly formed choir of Polish adults sang brackets of Polish songs and continental and Polish foods were available. Business was brisk and by late afternoon all stocks were sold.

The fair began impressively with Mass celebrated at 10.30 am by Fr. Richard Gamanski and Marian Laban. The official opening was performed by the President of the Federation of Polish Organisations in Victoria, Mr Z. P. Koziell.

The president of the Eastern Districts Polish Association, Mr Adam Szczesniak, welcomed guests of many nations.

More than 1500 people attended and special visitors included the MHR for Holt, Mr Bill Yates and his wife Camilla.

Twenty-three Polish firms and tradesmen displayed and sold their goods.

Guests were still dancing to the music of a Polish Band Neptune at 7pm.

The organisers said: "We were very happy to act as hosts and hostesses to our many Australian friends and we invite them and others interested to join our fellow countrymen and women at a picnic we will hold on February 17, 1980, also in Wellington Rd., Rowville."
