











POLISH ETHNIC SCHOOL

We are a Saturday School providing Polish language and culture classes to the Australian-Polish community in Melbourne. The school is a vital part of Eastern District Polish Association of Melbourne. It was established in 1956 by a group of parents. They recognised a need for their children to have some formal knowledge of the Polish culture and language and have actively encouraged the establishment and ongoing continuance of the school. The Polish Ethnic School is dedicated to promoting and preserving Polish culture. There are approximately 75 students enrolled, aged from 5 to 14 and grouped into 7 classes. The curriculum for 1st to 4th grades concentrate on reading, spelling and vocabulary, and for 5th to 10th grades, to assist students in building their skills in comprehension reading with an emphasis on Polish literature, history and geography. We pride ourselves on our modern teaching techniques and programs as well as organisational effectiveness, fulfilling requirements of the VIC Department of Education, which supervises our and other schools registered with the Department.
